By logging on to the Website, activating your password and creating user identification, you agree to be bound by this Cookie Policy as well as the terms or use, policies and procedures posted on our Website, under our Website Terms of Use and Website Disclaimer. To better serve you, we may use “cookies” to customize your browsing experience. Cookies are text files stored by your browser, and they provide a method of distinguishing among visitors to our sites. We may use “cookies” to store a randomly-generated tag on your computer device, so that when you revisit the Website, we may recognize you by the “cookie” and customize your experience. The Website may also use tracking pixels, web beacons, or other tracking technologies in addition to cookies. The cookies created on your computer by using the Website do not contain personal information. You may refuse a cookie, or delete the cookie file from your computer at any time. However, you should be aware that if you disable the “cookies” feature of your browser, you may not be able to use the Website. When you perform a search on the Website, we may record information identifying you or linking you to the search performed. RUSSO MEDIA GROUP may also record limited information for the search requests and use that information to resolve technical problems or to calculate overall usage statistics. You will find some specific examples of cookies and their use below.

What are cookies?

Cookies are simple data files or strings of information, usually stored as text. Cookies are stored on your computer or mobile device by a website’s server when you visit a website. Each cookie is unique to your web browser. It will contain some anonymous information such as a unique identifier, website’s domain name, and some digits and numbers.

What types of cookies do we use?

Necessary cookies

Necessary cookies allow us to offer you the best possible experience when accessing and navigating through the Website and using its features. For example, these cookies let us recognize that you have created an account and have logged into that account. The Website will use temporary or permanent cookies to offer extended functionality, security, and to enhance your browsing experience. These are called “first-party” cookies.

Functionality cookies

Functionality cookies let us operate the Website in accordance with the choices you make. For example, we will recognize your username and remember how you customized the Website during future visits.

Analytical cookies

These cookies enable us and third-party services to collect aggregated data for statistical purposes on how our visitors use or move about the Website. These cookies do not contain personal information such as names and email addresses and are used to help us improve your user experience of the Website because they tell us what features on the Website are working the best and what features can be improved.

Advertising Cookies

Advertising cookies are placed on your computer by affiliates, advertisers and ad servers in order to display advertisements that are most likely to be of interest to you. These cookies allow affiliates, advertisers and ad servers to gather information about your visits to the Website and other websites, alternate the ads sent to a specific computer or mobile device, and track how often an ad has been viewed and by whom. These cookies are linked to a computer or mobile device and do not gather any personal information about you. These are frequently called “third-party cookies”.

How to Disable or Delete Cookies?

Most browsers or mobile devices accept cookies by default (some accept cookies with limitations). If you want to restrict or block the cookies that are set by our website, you can do so through your browser or device settings, which are different for every computer, device, and operating system used. You will find general information about cookies and details on how to block, disable or delete cookies from your device. However, blocking, disabling or deleting cookies may affect the functionality the Website offers and may make it impossible for you to use the Website.
